## Louis Pasteur Bicentenary Prizes

To celebrate the 200th anniversary of the birth of Louis Pasteur a series of prestigious scientific prizes will be awarded for achievements that capture the Pasteur ethos (*l'esprit Pasteur*). These achievements should be in one or more of the fields of biomedical research, public health, or innovation.

The application should be submitted before the deadline of **September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022 (6:00 P.M, Paris Time)** via the dedicated application platform: [www.pasteur.fr/LP200prizes](http://www.pasteur.fr/LP200prizes)

### The application consists of:

- Candidate information (name, title, affiliation)
- Keywords defining the field of work
- A 750-word summary in English describing one achievement supported by a link to a seminal publication, clinical trial, intervention, device, or patent, as appropriate
- A short CV (no more than 2 pages)
- The five most significant publications

### RULES

Applications that do not meet the exact requirements will not be considered.

Laureates must be able to attend the award ceremony on the campus of the Institut Pasteur Paris on January 26<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

Each laureate must accept that his or her name be mentioned in the communication, and that his or her image and voice be collected during the filming of the event be disseminated worldwide by the Institut Pasteur, on all media, for a maximum period of one year after the award of the prize.
